



Parkland Bowbenders Archery Club RANGE RULES

- It is the responsibility of each archer to comply with safety rules and demonstrate common courtesy.
- Alcohol consumption and cannabis use is prohibited except for within personal campsites during special events approved by the PBAC Executive.
- 3. The gate must be closed and locked when entering and exiting the facility.
- 4. All persons using the range must be able to produce a valid range membership card upon request by PBAC Executive.
- No broadheads are allowed on the range unless you are shooting at a personally owned target brought to the range for that purpose.
- 6. No crossbows or firearms are allowed on the range.
- 7. If more than one archer is shooting on a static range, one of the archers must be designated to call "All Clear" when it is safe to cross the shooting line and "Clear to Shoot" when it is safe to do so.
- 8. Archers will not cross the shooting line until shooting has ceased and "All Clear" has been called.
- 9. Never nock an arrow until it is safe to shoot.
- 10. Shooting is only allowed from designated shooting positions. Extending the distance past the designated shooting position or across a trail is not allowed.
- 11. If you are alone and need to retrieve a lost arrow, ensure that:
 - There is a visible sign, such as a hanging bow, to ensure others know you are there.
 - b. You do not stray into other shooting lanes.
- 12. Dogs are allowed, but must be kept under control. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dog.
- 13. Do not litter. If you put up your own paper or tape targets, take them down when you leave.
- 14. Smoking is not permitted outside of the designated smoking area. Cigarette butts must be disposed of in the approved receptacle provided. Smoking is not permitted on the permanent static range or on the 3D loops.
- 15. Failure to comply with any of these Range Rules could result in cancellation of your range membership.
